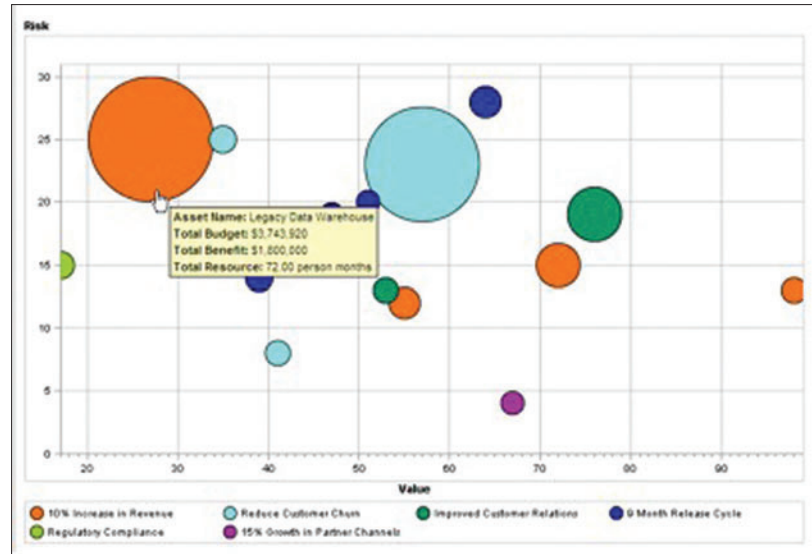
Optimize the value of your program management office

Provide visibility and control across projects

Each week, PMO staff members spend hours or even days compiling status reports from multiple data sources. HP PPM Program Management frees staff time by capturing all this information, consolidating it into a single repository and automatically rolling it up into an included dashboard.

HP PPM Program Management provides real-time project status to all project participants and stakeholders, using personalized dashboard pages. Red, yellow and green indicators show program health, real-time updates and notifications for exception conditions. Managers reviewing a program's summary project status can drill into project details, including individual tasks or outstanding issues. Many views let you act directly on the information, reducing the time lag and overhead associated with approvals, status updates and priority changes.

Using an intuitive user interface, you can model your programs in HP PPM Program Management, specify which projects roll up to each program and link projects to multiple programs. The end result is real-time access to all aspects of your complex programs.

Facilitate collaboration and stakeholder visibility

HP PPM Program Management provides a shared repository, visibility and security features to give all interested parties the information they need. It also includes best-practice processes for involving the right people at the right time. Resource requests and allocations follow a codified process so that your managers and stakeholders gain real-time visibility into resource requirements and the prioritized projects that generated them.

HP PPM Program Management helps you work with dependencies, linking tasks or even entire projects that affect another particular project or task. A powerful scheduling engine automatically takes these dependencies into account to keep project views up to date, letting you make appropriate tradeoffs, using real-time information across projects.

Best-practice processes for managing risk, scope changes, resource requests and issues enable programs to share common processes for "apples-to-apples" comparisons and reduced risk. Your stakeholders can track benefits as they occur from start to finish—a proof point on the road to BTO.

How HP PPM Program Management works

HP PPM Program Management provides the structure and processes for managing scope changes, risk, quality, issues, schedules, resources, releases and costs. You select which features to use out of the box, without losing the ability to adapt and extend these processes as your business changes. Adding and changing processes is simple to do with the drag-and-drop process modeler of HP Project and Portfolio Management (PPM) Foundation software. Each HP Project and Portfolio Management (PPM) Center™ module requires HP PPM Foundation software and the HP User Administration License.

HP PPM Program Management includes an out-of-the-box program initiation process to get you started. Forms specify what data is required, requisite approval steps and established program dashboards for visibility and real-time status. The process then verifies that required data is collected and that approvals and change requests are appropriately handled.

Program budgets, schedules and resources are created as part of the initiation process. Projects and project plans can be tied to a program for detailed work breakdown structures, task management or summary milestone reporting. Resource management is also easier—you can view and request resources by skill and by name so that all of your resource requests are in one place.
